Do Member Action Step Form. *Become a member, the form is very easy.*

Teach Member Action Step Form. *Very easy, especially after you have done your own. A very easy way to begin to help others.*

Invite Prospective Participants & Sponsors, *Takes preparation, but relatively easy if you have a marketing mindset.*

Become a Network Marketer or Affiliate, *First step is very easy, especially if you are an Action Planning member already. Making it work for you takes time, learning and persistence.*
